

Grégory THUAN Dit DIEUDONNE is an attorney at law and is well-known for his competencies in the field of international and European Law.

During his position as former senior case-processing lawyer at the European court of human rights (2002-2010) he was dealing with the applications brought before the ECHR against France and Monaco. In this aspect he had quasi-judicial duties while assisting the judges of the Court in processing the applications and in preparing the decisions and judgments adopted by the Strasbourg Court. From the stage of the introduction of the application to the adoption of the judgment the case-lawyers of the Court's Registry take an active part in the judicial proceedings of the Court with a high degree of analysis and legal expertise.

Besides this, Me Grégory THUAN Dit DIEUDONNE has represented the Court's Registry during different conferences provided to the groups of visitors (professors, penitentiary administration staff, attorneys-at-law, judges professional in the framework of their development programs) on the issues on the functioning of the Registry and the Court's caselaw. He was a speaker on several occasions during the external events¹.
